PARENT/GUARDIAN INVOLVEMENT INFORMATION

We encourage adult involvement in the programme. Parents and guardians are asked to help out by joining a parent roster that means attending a session once per term.

We also encourage parents to participate and contribute to the program by providing the Educators with information about their child, i.e. Through "All about me" and "cultural celebrations" and "Family Goal Sheets" as well as giving feedback and contributing their ideas to the program.

We encourage families to share their skills, resources and ideas whenever possible.

It is preferred that younger brothers/sisters do not attend the session, so that parents can spend the session with their three year old. However, if they are unable to find alternative care, this should not prevent them from participation. Any child, other than the three year old brought to the session, are the responsibility of the parent.

Parents are encouraged to involve themselves in the committee, and other functions such as busy bees, raffles, etc., as it is for the benefit of their children and the Family Centre.

Families will be kept in contact with the Woodlupine Family Centre 3 year old kindy via telephone, emails, newsletters, facebook and web site. This way, any news and information may be made quickly available to families and they may be asked for feedback and further involvement with the kindy or Family Centre services.
